Question: If prior to the fall of Adam and Eve, Adam was to "fill the earth" with children, what would have happened when the earth was filled? How does this relate to Jesus who was to come and reign as King on earth?

**Answer:** By virtue of God's command to Adam to *fill the earth* and steward it (Gn. 1:28), Adam was to fill the earth and care for it. While the Church has not made any official pronouncement on this matter, it is consistent with Luisa's text to affirm that once the earth was filled, Jesus would have come as a king with scepter in hand and accompanied by angels to become the head of the human race. To Luisa Jesus reveals:

"If Adam had not sinned, the Eternal Word who is the very Will of the heavenly Father, would have come to earth glorious, triumphant and reigning, accompanied visibly by his angelic army whom all were to see. And he was to come with the splendor of his glory to enthrall everyone and draw everyone to himself with his beauty, crowned as king with the scepter of command, so as to make himself king and head of mankind. He was to give souls the great honor of being able to say: "We have a king who is man and God". Indeed, your Jesus was to come down from heaven, not to find man infirm on account of having withdrawn himself from My Divine Will, but [in a state] where no illnesses of body or soul should exist" (L. Piccarreta, volume 25, March 31, 1929).

Adam, who was king of creation and the head of the human race, would now pass on this kingship to Christ, as there cannot be two kings reigning over the same kingdom. As for the earth Adam occupied before sin, it is *not* this earth. In point of fact, Paul reveals that this present earth is enslaved and subject to corruption (Rom. 8), which is not the case with the Garden of Eden that still exists in its unblemished state with a Cherub guarding its gates (Gn. 2.24). Moreover, Peter affirms that this present earth - not Eden - will be transformed by fire (2 Pt. 3.7ff). In short, based in Luisa's text, if Adam and Eve had not sinned, Jesus would have come to earth to reign in Eden - *not* in this enslaved and corrupt earth.
